<i>What can parents do to minimise the risk of infection?</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><i>- Keep the child at home until the blisters have dried and the child is feeling well.</i><i>- Encourage effective hand hygiene.</i><i>- Avoid contact between your child and other children or elderly people until the child is feeling better.</i>
