This includes (not limited to) confidence, turn taking, recognising their individual efforts and achievements and those of others, developing gross motor skills, hand eye coordination and manipulating equipment and managing tools.

YOGA LESSONS

Yoga provides an opportunity for children to become strong in their wellbeing. Children are able to increase their capacity to understand and self regulate, develop balance and coordination and recognise their individual efforts and achievements.

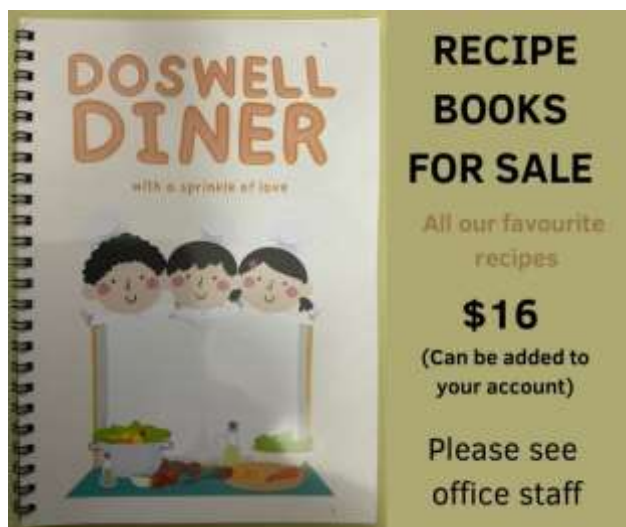
